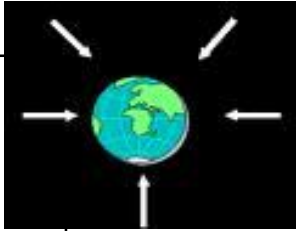


Understanding English, Communication, and Languages

- Investigating the effect of different forces.



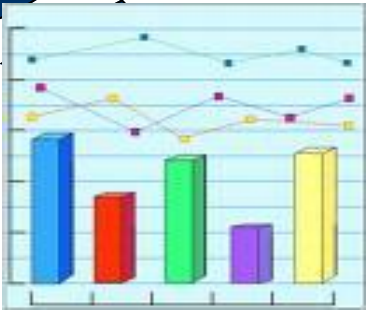
Understanding the Arts
