- Reading & retelling different Fairy Tales
- Exploring information books about animals
- -Making story props & using them in role play
- Telling own stories to act out in the 'stage'
- Writing for different purposes (wanted posters / letter of apology to the Bears)
- Making story maps

Physical Development

- Negotiating space by playing role play games - What's the time Mr Wolf?
- Using equipment and apparatus for a purpose (Troll bridge in the garden)
- Using tools safely (cutting)



Knowledge & Understanding of the World

- Building models of homes / bridges
- Looking at different materials to make collage (straw / sticks / bricks)
- Making porridge (noticing changes to materials)



- Looking at old & new equipment like chairs / telephones - talking about the past

- Counting characters
- Comparing, ordering & measuring characters
- Sequencing events from stories

- Considering the morals of the stories - looking at sharing & stranger danger
- Using role play to understand about friendships / conflicts

- Using Fairy Tales to develop creative work - collage / small world scenes / role play
- Role play areas = Three Bears house / Three little pigs houses / The Troll bridge
- Mask making / puppets of characters
- Playing music / moving to music / feelings
