Outcome

Write a letter to Gordon Brown expressing their views on Climate Change and what they would like him to do to help reduce it.



Scientific & Technological Understanding

Learn distinctions between herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

Outcome

To understand how animals are adapted to live in different habitats dependant on climate, food, shelter and safety.

To plan and carry out an investigation into conditions for growing plants in the classroom.
