Outcome

To understand the causes and effects of climate change and some of the actions that can be taken to combat it.

Publish a range of poems and information about climate change

Understanding the Arts

Explore different climate change logos and use these as a design source.

Using their own logo design, think of different ways it can be applied to a T-shirt.

Explore transfer paints, fabric pens and an assortment of materials.

Outcome

To understand the use of logos and how a message can be portrayed in symbols.

To gain a new skill by exploring different art materials and equipment.

Mathematical Understanding

Make and test general statements about number, sort and classify numbers and explain methods and findings

Compare two numbers by finding the difference between them

Select from a range of mental strategies for addition and subtraction of numbers with two significant figures

Visualise and understand multiplication, record multiplication as a number sentence and solve problems using number facts
