

Mathematical Understanding

- Understand the range of ways mathematics can be used to solve practical problems.
- Use numbers for measurement, quantification and comparison in different contexts.
- Use geometry to explore, understand and represent shape and space.

Outcome: To feel more confident with a range of mathematical concepts.

Scientific and Technological Understanding

- Review what they know about plants.
- Apply scientific knowledge and understanding to grow healthy plants.
- Investigate the structure, function, life cycle and growth of flowering plants and explain how these are linked.

Outcome: To grow their own healthy plants in a grow bag and be able to look after them properly using their knowledge of plants.

Understanding English, Communication, Languages
