Outcome:
To understand the meaning of the term "force"
To create a set of sound effects for a pirate play/opera.

Understanding Physical Development, Health & Well Being

- Weekly P.E. sessions- Dance, Gymnastics & swimming
- Develop physical competence in gymnastics
- Develop a dance routine including set moves and put to music
- Use of practise to improve performance of a dance sequence.

Outcome:
To be able perform and evaluate a dance/gymnastics routine.
To develop swimming skills
