Mathematical Understanding

- On-going work on addition and subtraction strategies.
- Investigate types of fraction.
- Practice partitioning up to five digit numbers.
- Identify parts of a fraction and use this to find fractions of amounts and shapes

Outcomes:

To have a secure and independent written method for addition and subtraction.
To know the value of each digit in numbers up to 5 digit numbers.
To be able to partition numbers in different ways.
To recognise $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ of shaded shapes.

Scientific & Technological Understanding

Explore the physical structure of the body of a butterfly and identify the different parts.
Investigate types and reasons for butterfly wing patterns.
Visit the Natural History Museum Butterfly House to experience real life examples of butterflies.
Investigate modelling materials and practice methods for joining them

Outcome :

To use cutting and joining skills to produce a model butterfly.
