### Communication, Language & Literacy Development

Reading stories about characters and their families.  
Looking at feelings and considering others  
Using information books to find out about ourselves  
Re-enacting experiences in the role play areas -  
(hairdressers, hospital, ASDA and the home corner)

#### Adult-led outcomes:

- To know that there are different families
- To talk about own family, feelings and home

### Problem Solving, Reasoning & Numeracy

Problem solving relating to real-life addition and subtraction Using vocabulary associated with Time. Measuring Time and talking about daily events  
Using money by recognising coins and understanding their value

#### Child-led outcomes:

- To understand daily events

### Knowledge & Understanding of the World

Finding out about the past by comparing old and new  
Using the sense of taste, touch, hearing, sight and smell  
Naming body parts  
Talking about own homes and comparing to other homes

#### Adult-led outcomes:

- To develop an awareness of the five senses
- To begin to notice the difference between old and new things

### Physical Development

Practising Sports day relay races  
Developing dances using bodies  
Handling tools safely when participating in activities

#### Adult-led outcomes:

- Able to take turns and participate in relay races
- To develop fine motor control during activities

## Ourselves & Others ~ for Nursery children

### Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Talking about feelings associated with change. Considering what it will be like next year in year one  
Talking about keeping safe at the seaside and stranger danger

#### Adult-led outcome:

- To understand the feelings of happiness, sadness and anger

### Creative Development

Recreating roles and experiences in our role play areas  
Matching feelings and moods to music  
Recording ourselves, our families and our feelings  
Looking at the Art work of Picasso and use ideas in our work

#### Child-led outcomes:

- To use gestures and actions to imagine and recreate experiences

#### Adult-led outcomes:

- To explore the sounds that instruments and our bodies make
