## Historical, Geographical and Social Understanding

## Mathematical Understanding

To have a secure written and independent strategy for addition and subtraction

To collect information and to present it in a block graph  
To ask and answer questions about the information in a graph

## Understanding English, Communication & Languages

- Identify the features of a sentence
- Learn and apply Phonics
