

Understanding English, Communication, and Languages

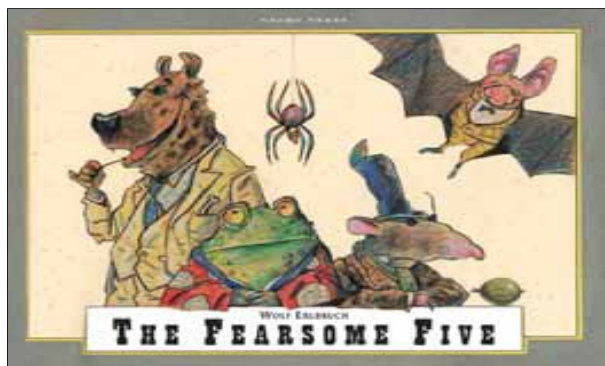
Children will:

- Organise their ideas; plan draft and publish written work with care
- Experiment with a variety of punctuation improving in accuracy and effect
- Listen and respond critically to a text; analyse and evaluate the ideas within it
- Retell a story improving their use language for effect
- Explore character, setting and plot and how they work together
- Rewrite a story being ambitious with the effect and accuracy of their written work
- Read a range of texts for pleasure and information
- Be learning French!

Outcomes:

Children set goals for themselves and know how to improve their work

Historical, Geographical and Social Understanding

Children will:

- Compare locations within and outside of the UK using a variety of geographical resources and consider the varied experiences of people living in different places
- Understand Earth's place in the solar system and be able to explain how day and night occurs and the passage of months and years

Outcomes

Children will recording each other communicating and modelling their understanding of the above

You and Me

This term we will be thinking about who we are, what makes us unique and how we can appreciate and respect what is special about everyone in our class.

Mathematical Understanding

Children will:

- Use their understanding of place value to know the relative size of numbers
- Round numbers to the nearest 1/10/100
- Explore and create number sequences
- Secure a written strategy for addition and subtraction
- Be able to use the inverse to check their calculations
- Ask good questions
- Choose effective ways of collecting and presenting information
- Interpret information from charts and graphs
- Use ICT to organise, present and compare data

Outcomes:

Feel confident that they understand the value of digits

Recognise number patterns

Have efficient written strategies for addition and subtraction

Be able to organise and present information with accuracy and clarity

Understanding the Arts

Children will:

- Respond critically to the work of Pablo Picasso and Cubism
- Draw from observation
- Visit the National Portrait Gallery to study character and style
- Evaluate and improve their observational drawing
- Explore and compare perspectives
- Notice and use colour to communicate feeling



Outcomes:

An expressive self portrait influenced by the ideas of Cubism

Understanding Physical Development, Health and Wellbeing



Children will:

- Develop confidence in the water through playing water polo
- Improve hand-eye co-ordination, spatial awareness in through playing netball
- Build a Good Sporting Attitude (GSA)
- Explore sense of self and use this to connect with others
- Understand and respect difference

Outcomes:

Increased fitness, confidence and co-ordination

Children will feel confident, happy, settled and able to work and play with one another
