

Reception children's ideas about 'Fairy Tales' include: Starts with "once upon a time", "lives happily ever after", has "bad people and good people" in it. The children were able to name many Fairy Tales.

Communication, Language & Literacy Development

- Reading different Fairy Tales
- Retelling Fairy Tales in role play areas

Adult-led outcomes:

- ✓ To retell the story of the Three Billy Goats Gruff using Talk for Writing
- ✓ To read and write simple words
- ✓ To collaboratively publish own version of a Fairy Tale
- ✓ To film own version of collaborative Fairy Tale

Physical Development

- Indoor Gymnastics sessions focusing on the use of space and using apparatus safely
- Outdoor weekly PE sessions

Adult-led outcomes:

- ✓ To develop an awareness of contrast in speed and levels during indoor PE sessions
- ✓ To use a ball with confidence and increasing control

Knowledge & Understanding of the World

- Reception club looking at different materials focusing on the story of the Three Little pigs
- Using different materials to recreate scenes / objects from Fairy Tales

Adult-led outcomes:

- ✓ To show an understanding of different materials and words to describe them

Child-initiated outcomes:

- ✓ To construct with a purpose in mind

Problem Solving, Reasoning & Numeracy

- Developing an understanding of counting, ordering and calculating

Adult-led outcomes:

- ✓ To be able to recognise and order numerals
- ✓ Use existing knowledge of one more and one less to solve simple addition and subtraction problems

Creative Development

- Weekly music sessions
- Reception club - making houses using different techniques such as painting and printing

Adult-led outcomes:

- ✓ Recognising sound patterns
- ✓ Exploring how sound can be changed
- ✓ Matching movements to music
- ✓ Creating scenery for the parent show

- Weekly circle-time sessions focusing on what we like and how we feel

Adult-led outcome:

- ✓ To develop confidence when speaking in a group

How you can help at home

- ✓ Encourage your child to talk about and retell known Fairy Tales
- 3 Billy Goats Gruff / 3 Little pigs / 3 Bears
- ✓ Talk about different homes that you can see on the way home from school and what they are made from
- ✓ Use recycled materials to build models with your child (the three little pigs houses)
- ✓ Read your book every night and record in reading diary at least twice per week for a superstamper
- ✓ Bring in school fund once per week
