Children will:

- Read and discuss a range of poetry
- Refine their reading skills in Destination Reader lessons, reading *Seven Ghosts* by Chris Priestley
- Read and discuss stories from a wide range of mystery/ghost stories
- Discuss and identify the audience and purpose of ghost/mystery stories
- Explore characters and settings
- Develop knowledge of advanced language and punctuation

So that they...

Understand and respond to poetry in both verbal and written form
 Can use a wide range of reading skills to engage with what they read and have a deeper understanding of the text
 Can write effectively for a range of purposes and audiences, selecting appropriate language
 Can describe settings, characters and atmosphere in narratives using language features such as:

- Where, when, how and why adverbials and prepositions
- Expanded noun phrases for precision
- Actions, speech manner and appearance
- Variety of sentence types

Can integrate dialogue in narratives to convey character and advance the action

Can use a range of devices to build cohesion (such as, adverbials) within and across paragraphs

Maths

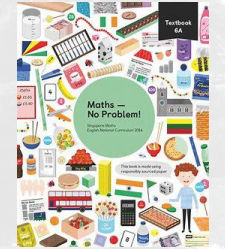
Children will:

- Convert units of length, mass, volume and time
- Find and use percentages of a number, quantity and change
- Solve problems involving ratio
- Describe, write, evaluate and use algebraic expressions
- Find the area and perimeter of rectangles, parallelograms and triangles
- Find the volume and solve problems involving cubes and cuboids
- Investigate and solve problems involving angles

So that they...

Understand a variety of complex mathematical concepts.
 Can solve mathematical problems using a variety of skills and knowledge.
 Are confident with a strategy for each calculation and know when to use them.

Understand how to use and apply the maths they have learnt.
 Know what strategy is needed to answer a question.
 Work quickly and efficiently.



RE

Children will:

- Learn in depth from two different religions about why their holy buildings and works of art matter to them as expressions of devotion to God and worship, and about how they practice generosity and charity.
- Explore the big question:

Is it better to express your religion in arts & architecture or in charity & generosity?

So that they...

Engage in systematic enquiry into significant human questions which religion and worldviews address
 Can develop the understanding and skills needed to appreciate and appraise varied responses to these questions
 Develop responses of their own.

Art

Children will:

- Learn about the meaning of Expressionism
- Explore the effect of different art media such as pastels, oil pastels and paint
- Create their own 'Expressionist inspired' artwork

- Understand how can artists convey an expression of feeling through their work
- Can produce their own piece of art
